IDE BETTER RUN vied up front while three wide and between rivals, garnered a larger advantage in the turn, clear into the lane, crossed to the rail, held the runner up comfortably safe in the late going. HELLA BELLA with the early pace, shuffled back in tight quarters into the turn, dropped inside late in the bend, moved back out and finished up willingly to earn the place. IDEALIEN behind the pace, moved out to be four wide and to challenge late in the turn, could not do much with the winner in the drive, outkicked for the place. CLASSY IDE off the pace along the inside, continued to save ground through the turn, improved position while not a serious threat. COLLEGE BOUND KATE broke alertly, fell back, raced outside and lacked a serious rally. STORMY BRICK ROAD contested the pace three wide for three furlongs and began to give way. KELLYS SPECIAL failed to menace. KEY LEE showed early speed toward the inside, gave way.
