BELL SARA devoid speed, rallied mid track and got up for second. TWO STALL reserved, was asked turning for home and then lacked a finish. KRISTINA'S DAY vied for the lead to approaching mid stretch and then weakened late. SNOW MOUNTAIN was outrun. LILKILNGIRL vied for the lead to approaching the drive and then tired. TUNE A WIN FOR A B showed speed along the inside to the turn and then faded. LIL IRISH EYES was no real threat.
