TEY'S BIG BOY forwardly placed in the two path, advanced on the leader out of the turn, lugged in when challenging past the furlong marker, all out to be just up. RED SALT broke well, with the pace, shook clear in the turn, responded when challenged by the winner when straightened for home, proved stubborn to the end, just nipped. GOOD FLAMIN FRYDIE fractious in the post parade, settled off the pace, waited briefly in traffic entering the stretch, asked to run when clear, finished willingly to be rapidly getting to the top two. A RANG A TANG settled behind the pace, lacked a closing response in the drive. ONE FAST CAJUN devoid off early foot, found best stride late through traffic. I'M INDY GOLD off the early pace, made good improvement toward the inside late in the turn, angled out for the drive, flattened out in the late going. EXTRA SHOES four out to five wide in the turn, angled to the far outside bothering an outer foe, went evenly in the drive. COOL CAJUN away in good order, good speed along the inside, faltered in the drive. MAJOR RYAN O'QUINN off slow, picked off some tiring foes. NICENE CREED five out to six wide late turn, bothered into the lane, failed to rally. LAUGHING RAIL trailed for a half, passed tiring foes. IDE BETTER faded in the drive. SALTY'S TOWN forwardly placed early, began a steady retreat before a half.
