Footnotes

SWEETTALKIN HOTTIE allowed to settle into stride early outside a rival, began to advance four wide on the second turn, swung six wide into the lane, dueled with HONEY DEW in the drive and proved best late. HONEY DEW stalked the pace along the inside for a half mile, raced four wide on the second turn, assumed command into the lane and was overtaken by the winner with a sixteenth of a mile to run. CALLEY'S ROCKET broke sharply and was unhurried early while saving ground, moved up between rivals on the second turn and showed good late effort. FAPIANO QUEEN was content to trail the field early while saving ground and found her best stride late. MACARONI'S DEELITE was away alertly, stalked the pace along the inside and showed no late response. WIN FRIENDLY pressed the pace along inside and tired in the final furlong. GOOD THEATER went to the front shortly after the start, saved ground while setting the pace, opened up a clear lead down the backstretch and stopped after six furlongs.
