DEPUTIFORMER unhurried early began to advance after six furlongs, slipped through along the rail to challenge under clever handling past the furlong marker, gained the advantage and dug in late go narrowly prevail. AND MUSIC CAME allowed the pace to go early inside, rallied four wide out of the final turn, lost some ground to the winner, roused, finished up willingly to narrowly miss. SNAKEBITE KIT moved up to vie four wide through the first turn, fell back off the pace, went back to challenge on the outside late in the second turn, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, not enough in the late going. BRENTWOOD BULLET with the pace from the start, continued to contest the issue the middle half, shook briefly clear in the far turn, vied into the stretch off the inside, allowed the winner the rail a furlong out, proved stubborn until late. SCRAPPY ROO forwardly placed toward the inside, lacked a closing kick. DUKE OF HOMBERG (GB) last away, trailed for five furlongs, picked off a couple of tiring foes. IDE LIKE A DOUBLE settled in the early going, had nothing for the drive. SUSHI JOE was finished early. ASHE'S CAT set or forced a lively pace, stopped in the second turn, entymate rallied to win.
