RUSTON ROBBER broke alertly, settled off the leaders going to the turn, ranged up outside RUN OVER ME RADE in upper stretch, took over and then proved best while kept to a drive. TIMELY SWEEP stalked RUN OVER ME RADE to before the drive, dropped back a bit and then came again to get up for second. RUN OVER ME RADE moved clear quickly, got headed nearing mid stretch and then drifted out late. KIMUA MAN devoid speed, showed late interest. MARK SAFELY saved ground too no avail. OUR CAJUN HUFF saved ground from early on and then faded. BANDIT'S BOOTY lunged at the break, advanced from between foes before the turn, swung out for the drive and then flattened out. CUBAN COURAGE showed little. ORDER OF THE COURT raced wide. INTREPID STORM was no real threat.
