**Footnotes**

FISH CAKES stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded when asked to gain the margin and was clear late while kept to task. ALCHEMIZED chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but could only gain the place. FOREVER WAITING far back early, advanced inside entering the turn, responded to pressure and had good energy late. CACTUS MAX forced the early pace from the inside but was no threat late. MILLERS BOY could only improve position. PORT IN CHINA dueled from the inside and tired. DAKOTA COMET was no

factor. HONEY JUNIOR was no threat. LORD AUBREY dueled from the outside and tired. WAITINGTOBEKING chased the early pace and tired. RED WILD AND BLUE was no menace. GLITTERY AND FORTY dueled from between foes and tired. MARAZI'S CAT was never close.
