WELL'S GOLD a bit slow to start, asked, advanced into a forward position into the turn, bid, took over entering the stretch, quickly clear, drew out under steady handling. TOUGH AS NAILS off the pace, steady gain while four wide through the turn, no match for the winner late, up for the place. GREER'S TARGET lacked speed, was five wide out of the turn, roused, gaining for the place. MUZHNIK forward and toward the inside for a half, backed up through the stretch. BAD FOOTED GRADY narrowly set the pace for a half, weakened when headed by the winner entering the stretch. ANCHORED BACK lacked a late bid. RAYS ROADRUNNER in some traffic in the early going, faded. TAUNT DIABLO last away, trailed throughout.
