ELUSIVE MAN devoid speed, rallied wide and got up for the show. ZAVATA EXPRESS vied for the lead to the drive, then faltered late. SEVEN POINT SEVEN allowed to settle, was no real threat. BUST A GROOVE raced inside and was outrun. MERTZ'S SECRET raced wide. GIANT SHAMROCK was never dangerous. PORCUPINE BOOM showed early foot, then weakened. OUR SLEW O CHANGES moved to the rail early and was not a factor. SHARP RULER between foes early, lugged out around the turn.
