ISABELLA SYMPHONEY void of speed off the inside, came three wide out of the final turn when beginning to rally, finished strong to win going away. SPRUCE'S SPIRIT far back, began to move on the outside midway on the second turn while outside the winner, came five wide into the lane, could not match strides with the victor, willingly to be up for the place. H AND F'S PROSPECT broke with the field, settled on the outside, advanced, took over, showed the way past the furlong marker but would prove no match for the top two. COREY'S RED BOY in the second flight, set down for the drive, lacked a finishing kick. BIDE settled off the pace, middle move to challenge, brief lead late final turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. TIME TO REIGN tracked the pace along the inside for five furlongs, had little left. CATCH ME DADDY four wide into the first turn, lacked a rally. PEOTONE BREEZE outrun, failed to respond when asked in the drive. BOLD LOUISA'S BOY remained back, traffic far turn. ROCK 'N RAIL tired in the drive. CHIEF WATERBURY narrowly set the pace for five furlongs and stopped. ROUGHOUSE dueled up front for four furlongs and also stopped.
