REGAL LEAH moved up to show the way early, got well clear in the turn while rating kindly, continued to hold a large advantage past the furlong marker, caught late. PAWPAW'SLILSYDNEY settled off the pace, saved ground into the lane, mild rally, no match for the top two. WATCHING BETH evenly paced in lacking a closing response. ROYAL DIANA remained back. STORMIN RILEY pressured the runner up early, stopped. AMY MY AMY was through early.
