JOHN CHARLES stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded when asked to gain a clear margin at the eighth pole then was all out to last. LYD RIVER broke in a tangle, chased the early pace from between foes, altered outside for the drive, responded but just missed. BLUEHARD close up from the outside early, held a forward position for the drive but could not keep pace. POWER SURGE outrun early, advanced inside entering the turn, responded and finished well but too late. CUPID'S HIT dueled from the outside and tired. BRENDYN JO could only pass tired ones. MR. PORTER was no factor. HUFFS HUNTER dueled from the inside and tired. RAIL RIDGE had a steady fade.
