DECLAN'S FAST CAT chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, gained the margin at the eighth pole and held off TEN INDIAN the final furlong while under steady urging. TEN INDIAN stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced through the turn, responded when asked but could not reach the winner. AARON'S BLUFF broke sharp from between foes, gained a clear early margin, remained clear through the turn, held a forward position for the drive but had no late response. BRAHMS GENTLEMAN chased the early pace from the inside, responded entering the drive but was too late. DIXIE WINTER forced the early pace outside but had nothing left for the drive. NEGOTIATION was no threat. KIKAZARU was no factor. PAPAS POT OF GOLD was never close.
