RIDE THE WAKE broke attentively, allowed the pace to go while off the inside, ranged up four wide to challenge turning for home, drove steadily clear. JUST CATIN behind the pace, moved up with the winner inside that one to challenge exiting the turn, no match late, fully extended to narrowly hold the place. CANDI'S KITTEN within striking distance along the inside, steadied when in a bit tight entering the turn, remained within striking distance, rail bid into lane, long drive for the place, outfinished. RED HOT DEAL stumbled badly at the start, fell back, carried out six wide into the stretch, displayed some late interest down the center of the strip. MOTOROLA JADE lacked speed, carried foe out 1/4, picked off a couple of tiring foes. WERBLIN PHONE made little impact while saving ground. K. C.'S CANDY sprinted well clear soon after the start, headed turning for home, steered out, continued to fade. GOOD HOPE GIRL closest to the early leader, stopped.
