**Footnotes**

STONE SKIPPER stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily inched closer up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, dueled with MR CHUB through the drive and outnodded that one late. MR. CHUB unhurried early from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive to duel through the drive with the winner but was outnodded. ALL STAR COLTON dueled from the inside early, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn but could not keep pace through the drive. HARDTENONTHEHOP outrun early, advanced inside entering the second turn, responded along the rail and had good energy late. COLE'S MAGIC STAR could only pass tired ones. PIE'S CHOICE well placed from the inside, crept closer up the backstretch, made a bid entering the second turn but faltered in the drive. PACIFIC CURE was no factor. LITTLEBITCAJUN forced the early pace and tired. LITTLE WHISKEY had a steady fade. CASTNET KENT dueled from the outside and gave way.
