DREAMIN FOOL chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the turn, gained a clear advantage entering the drive, remained well clear at the eighth pole and held sway. ONLY THE STRONG dueled from between foes for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, remained forward for the drive but was no match while clearly second best. ROCK A BY ZAP chased the early pace from between foes, steadily advanced entering the turn, responded and finished well. LAURENT DU VAR stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but was no threat late.

MAYBE LOCO could only improve position. HE BE WILD chased the early pace from the inside but had nothing left. SOVEREIGN DAY was no factor. RAPT ATTENTION was no threat. T HALL dueled from the inside and tired. CAJUN GENTLEMEN chased the early pace outside and tired. BIGOLCOUNTRYBOY had a steady fade. ROYALEE BRED had little interest. INDY'S EYE was never close. BROCKBERG was pulled up and vanned off.
