### Footnotes

SOUTHERN STYLE outprinted in the early going, came four wide out of the turn, challenged soon after, long drive, proved narrowly best in game fashion. CHIEF JAY trailed early along the inside, moved out, came in the five path and outside the winner exiting the turn, dueled to the wire with that foe, missed. SPARKLING KEAT showed the way early, raced in the two path when continuing to set the pace out of the turn, proved stubborn until very late. DANCE CALLER forwardly placed inside, shuffled back early in the turn, continued inside, gaining for the show spot late, no threat to the top two. TORTUGA STRAITS in the second flight early, chased the leader in the two path through the turn, had little left in the late going while racing in some traffic past the sixteenth mile marker.
