CARSON THE GREAT back early, rushed up five wide approaching the turn, bid three wide around the turn and proved clearly best. VALID CAJUN raced wide and was along or second. LEBTON forwardly placed off the rail, bid three wide nearing mid stretch and then hung. DO RIGHT DON close up from early on, had no final kick. ORIEAUX inside to the drive, eased out turning for home and then lacked a serious rally. YUKON BANDIT devoid speed, rallied outside and closed mildly. TAKE THE WIN cleared to the inside down the backstretch, was displaced before the drive and then faded along the rail. ENTER THE LION raced wide. LUKEY'S LEGEND between foes early, was not a factor. MALAGRA GOLD tired. DEPUTY DEAL showed little. SA IVAN was never dangerous. BOLIVAR SHAGNASTY was always back.
