EASY TO PLEASE ME broke sharp from the inside, dueled for the early lead, gained a clear margin entering the turn, widen the effort at the eighth pole and was in hand throughout. FOLSOM TIME chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the turn but could only gain the place. IN MOTION stalked the early pace from between foes, made a bid entering the turn but could not keep pace. FORTY MORE WINS pressed the early pace from the inside but had nothing left. FORTY WON SMARTS went evenly. ROBIN'S SPORT dueled from the outside early and tired. MAJOR RYAN O'QUINN was no factor. BLAKE'S REVENGE had a steady fade. MAOTAI was never close.
