### Footnotes

BATTLE BOOGIE unhurried early from the outside, tracked the pace up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and steadily drew clear. HURRICANE RITA well placed from the inside, crept close entering the second turn, responded but could not match strides. SMART AND SWEET stalked the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the second turn but was too late. GYPSY TRIAL chased the early pace outside but had nothing left. LEE'S ZEAL dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged through the second turn but tired in the drive. FILLY IN PINK was no factor. ADDIE'S DREAM was never close. ZEE JOLIE was no threat. ERL GIRL dueled from the inside and gave way.
