CAPTAIN SUNSHINE stalked the early pace from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive, gained the advantage at the eighth pole and steadily drew clear while kept to task. TWINSTORM dueled from between foes for the early lead, battled through the second turn, dropped back at the eighth pole, responded to come again for the place. MILITARY OFFICER dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, battled through the second turn but could not keep pace. RAMBO DAY pressed the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, made a bid along the rail to gain a short margin entering the drive but could not sustain the effort. MISTA BAD ATTITUDE could only improve position. MR BARRETTE RUN went evenly. KING RYE was no factor. WILL'S DIAMOND was no threat. HEY RUSTON dueled from the outside and gave way and was eased at the finish.
