WALK EASY broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, continued to show the way entering the second turn, widen the advantage at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task. QUAZAR chased the early pace from the outside, remained forward entering the second turn but was no match for the winner while second best. TIME TO REIGN stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the second turn, responded but could only gain the show. LONE RENEGADE unhurried early, advanced inside entering the second turn, responded but was too late. WAGON TROUBLE forced the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. ROYAL PEBBLES went evenly. SCHUMACHER pressed the early pace and tired. COLLEGE FUND forced the early pace and tired. LAKE G P was no factor. HOLD ON LEDELL was never close.
