ROCK HARD stalked the early going from the inside, crept closer up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, dueled with EURO CASH and ATOMIC FORCE, remained engaged through the drive and inched clear late under steady urging. EURO CASH broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, dueled with the winner through the drive but could not match strides. ATOMIC FORCE well placed from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn but could not keep pace through the drive. CLEVER DANZIG chased the early pace from the inside but could only improve position. POPLARSAINTE raced evenly. KEEP THE MONEY was no factor. BANGO had a steady fade. CRIDER chased the early pace from the outside, stopped in the drive and walked off.
