IDEFROMTHEBAYOU stalked the early pace from the inside, dropped back slightly entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, responded when asked and was along in time. SOUTHERN INVASION unhurried early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded entering the drive but could only gain the place. CUPID'S HIT broke sharp from the outside to gain the early margin, dueled up the backstretch, opened a clear margin entering the second turn, held a clear advantage at the eighth pole but could not last. ELUSIVE COMMANDER outrun early, advanced outside entering the drive but was too late. FIRST TO BINGO chased the early pace from the inside but had nothing left. SPRIGHTLY STAR forced the early pace inside and tired. SEA THE SOLDIER was never close. ONE PRETTY PENNY was no factor. LITTLE DOLLAR chased the early pace outside and tired.
