CONSERVATISM up close early from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, dueled through the drive with COUPEE through the drive and inched clear of that one late. COUPEE broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, dueled through the second turn, remained engaged through the drive with the winner but could not match strides. FORTY WON'S IDEE unhurried early, steadily advanced entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive but could only gain the show. PLEASANTLY FREE pressed the early pace outside but had nothing left for the drive. PREAPPROVED forced the early pace from between foes but had no late response. VIC O HONEY went evenly. GOLD CAT could only pass tired ones. KING GEE was no factor. LONESOME COWBOY chased the early pace inside and tired. ROB HOW was no threat. TREY'S GOODBYE stopped up the backstretch and was eased both stretch and finish. AFTERNOON MAN showed little and was eased both stretch and finish.
