### Footnotes

FISH CAKES well placed from the outside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive and was just up the final stride. TRULAKE dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch, gained a clear margin entering the second turn, remained clear at the eighth pole but was caught the final stride. PERFECT JADE stalked the early pace from between foes, made a bid entering the second turn and was gaining late. SIR KING CAT chased the early pace from the inside but had nothing left for the drive. DASH RIP ROCK unhurried early, advanced outside entering the second turn, responded and finished well but too late. LIME ME pressed the early pace outside but had no late response. IRISH CONFIDANT was no factor. PIANO RULES was no threat. WHOS YOUR DAD broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, dueled up the backstretch then tired. SHINEMAN showed little. MOTORMECH was never close. LANDOPEDUSA pressed the early pace and gave way.
