POLY SAUCE was settled then rallied on the turn while three wide, angled out to be six wide off of BIG BISCUIT heels in upper stretch, was in a strong drive and drew off in late stretch. BIG BISCUIT was unruly behind the gate prior to loading then rallied two wide on the turn, made a strong bid then drifted out in upper stretch, dug in gamely then weakened but held the place safe in the end. FLEETING WILL was unhurried early then rallied on the turn, swung out to be six wide and closed willingly in the stretch drive. ROYAL SNOW was allowed to settle then raced on the turn while three wide then failed to menace in the stretch. N UMBRELLABAG NITE was inside and saving ground on the turn but was no menace in the stretch drive. T'S BABY GIRL chased the early pace while two wide, was used up and stopped in the stretch. RUSSELLVILLE RAID was outrun. TAG YOUR IT set the early pace while being hard used then stopped in the stretch.
