K C SHUFFLE stalked the early pace while racing two wide, rallied heading into the far turn to duel for the lead, gained command then drew off in mid stretch and was kept to task in the end. WAGON TROUBLE was allowed to settle in the early going while inside, rallied on the far turn then moved out to be three wide for the stretch and was gaining ground to be second best. CLOSING PRAYER set the early pace while being well handled, was collared on the far turn and dueled to upper stretch then weakened in the stretch drive. TRACK RECORD was allowed to settle then raced on the inside of the far turn making a mild bid then was evenly in the stretch drive. DR. SCHWARTZ was unhurried early while racing two wide, made a mild rally while three wide on the far turn but was no menace in the stretch drive. BOSTON MYSTERY chased the early pace while racing three wide, was hard used on the far turn then gave way in the stretch. HILLBILLY JAY chased the early pace from while two wide, was used up and stopped. BACK OFF SATAN was unhurried early while racing on the inside then was no factor.
