PORT IN CHINA stalked the early going from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late while under steady urging. FOLDED well placed from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded to pressure entering the drive but could not keep pace late. SOLDIER ON GO unhurried early from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded when asked and was gaining late. STAR ELETE allowed to settle early, advanced inside entering the second turn, responded and had good energy late. SOUTH WEST TARGET dueled from the inside early, battled up the backstretch, remained engaged through the drive but tired. HEROS SOUL went evenly. LIL FORTY dueled from the outside and tired. THE A. C. MAN was no factor. MARAZI'S CAT hesitated at the start and no threat. MILLERS BOY was no threat. KO PRO walked out at the start and never a threat. IZZY'S INDY chased the early pace and gave way.
