HEZALOTTA WANDA dueled from between foes for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive with the winner but could not match strides. STEALING COPPER dueled from the inside for the early lead, battled through the turn but could not keep pace. PENNANT CHASE chased the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the turn and finished well. FLYING IDE went evenly. MIGHTY ELK dueled from the outside and tired. SIR SULLY chased the early pace and tired. SOCCER PRINCE was never close. ELLE UNION showed little.
