WIRE ME ESKIMO chased the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded when asked and wore down rivals the final furlong. STING N BUG up close early from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive, gained a short advantage deep stretch but could not last. RAILROAD SHOW broke slow at the start, recovered to rush up from the outside, made a bid entering the turn and finished well. DOC R U IT pressed the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, gained the margin at the eighth pole but tired late. ZAVATA HEART chased the early pace from the inside, made a bid along the rail and had good energy late. LUCKY LIL GREELEY dueled from the inside and tired. GREAT AND TOUGH dueled from between foes and tired. FIESTY GERALD dueled from the outside and tired. RAHY BALBOA dueled from between foes and

tired. PLAYPRETTYLOUIE was no factor. WHAT SECRET was no threat. UNBRIDLED TOUCH had little interest. TRIBUTE'S BEST ONE forced the early pace outside and stopped in the drive.
