WIRETOWIRE WINNER was inside and saving ground on the turn, rallied then swung out to be four wide in mid stretch then was gaining ground in late stretch to finished strong. TEXASLEESTOWN vied for the lead while racing three wide, was in a long sustained drive then weakened in late stretch. WAY TOO HIGH was settled then bumped heading into the turn while three wide then failed to menace in the stretch. STORMIN RILEY was allowed to settled then was bumped while four wide heading into the turn then was no menace. HAILEY LITTLE SIS was unhurried early then moved out to be seven wide and made a late gain. SACK O ROCKS vied for the lead from between rivals, was hard used then stopped in the stretch. TRIBUTE'S FLAME chased the early pace then swung out to be four wide in upper stretch but faltered in the drive.
