TRACK BULLY was well placed while racing two wide, rallied heading into the far turn then assumed command, drew clear in mid stretch and was clearly much the best in the end. THEY CALL HIM EL was allowed to settle while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn making a bid to upper stretch but was no match for the winner in late stretch. ONE FAST CAJUN was unhurried early then saved ground on the far turn, made a mild rally in the stretch but was no menace. CERTIFIEDNBONEFIED was allowed to settle while racing three wide on the backstretch then failed to menace. COMMAND OUTPOST set a pressured pace from the inside, was hard used and gave way on the far turn. POPLARSAIN was unhurried early and no factor. WON DA FARM was chasing the early pace from the inside, was through after a half then stopped. MARQINDY was through after a half and stopped.
