BAD JOHN dueled from the outside early, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive with HE'S A SLEWVESCENT and outnodded that one late. HE'S A SLEWVESCENT dueled from the inside early, battled through the turn, remained engaged through the drive but was outnodded. WONDERLIC stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could only hold position. CYA LATER BERT chased the early pace from the outside, steadily advanced entering the turn and finished well. ESPRETO forced the early pace from the outside but had nothing left. PHANTOM STRIKE went evenly. FIRST COMMAND was no factor. FIERY CHOICE chased the early pace and tired. SUGAR BOWL DAY had a steady fade. J R'S WILD EVENT had little interest.
