TUPELO HONEY broke sharp from the outside, quickly gained the early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, continued to show the way through the second turn, responded entering the drive and held sway. ANGEL FISH unhurried early from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive and was getting to the winner. HER'S A GIRL pressed the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, responded entering the drive but could not keep pace. BET DAT chased the early pace from the outside, held a forward position through the second turn but had nothing left. HUGHES YOUR MOMMA close up outside, had no late response. STORMIN D. D. went evenly. BOOM BOOM DYNAMITE was no factor. GOTTA WINK had a steady fade.
