Footnotes

TENSAS CANEBRAKE up close early from the inside, inched closer up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive, gained the advantage and was well clear while kept to task. SAM THE SHIFTER stalked the early pace from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded along the rail but was no match for the winner. PIRATE ISLAND broke in at the start bothering inside rivals, chased the early pace, dropped back up the backstretch, responded to pressure to come again but too late. KNIGHT OF HONOR dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained forward entering the second turn but had nothing left. SKYMAX was rank early, dueled from the inside for the early advantage, gained a clear margin up the backstretch then tired in the drive. SOUTH WEST TARGET was pinched back at the start and never close. TRULAKE broke out at the start bothering rivals and showed little.
