PALE BLAZER dueled from the outside for the early lead, shook loose entering the turn, widen the advantage at the eighth pole and was well clear while kept to task in course record time. CALL chased the early pace from the inside, altered outside for the drive but could only gain the place. POWER SURGE outrun early, advanced inside, responded along the rail and was gaining late. JEDEDIAH pressed the early pace from the outside, responded and finished well but too late. BIG ADAM close up inside, had no late response. HIGH TONED forced the early pace and tired. WISH YOU GOLD had a steady fade. JOHN CHARLES was no factor.
