SOUTHERN STYLE outrun early, advanced inside entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive along the rail and was just up the final strides. ROYAL PRODUCTION up close early from the inside, held a forward position for the drive, responded to gain a clear margin but could not last. SWEETSOUTHERNMOON stalked the early pace from the inside, responded entering the drive and was gaining late. SOLAR CHARGE forced the early pace from between foes but had nothing left. CHIEF JAY was no factor. TORO BRAVO chased the early pace and tired. BLACK IDA'S JO JO broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear entering the drive but gave way.
