KING BANDIT broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, widen the effort entering the turn, remained well clear at the eighth pole and proved much the best while never asked and an easy winner. SO PREDICTABLE chased the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but was no match while second best. PINECREST PIRATE far back early, advanced outside entering the turn, responded and finished well. THREE LEGGED outrun early, could only improve position. WIRED SHARP forced the early pace from the inside and tired. WADEAGUSKA chased the early pace and tired. ROBIN'S SPORT up close early, gave way in the drive.
