HOLLY BEACH vied for the lead between foes and faded once reaching mid stretch. KATIE BUG saved ground until the drive, eased out and lacked a rally. MARTHA MAE back early, improved position. TIME FOR A PEACH was outrun. LOVELY LESLEY showed speed for a half and gave way. TOO CALM trailed and was not a factor. OH YEA YIE was always back.
