TENSAS COTTON GIN up close early from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole and was well clear while lightly roused. GYPSY'S DREAM stalked the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the turn, responded but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. SKY LILLY well placed from the outside, made a bid entering the turn and finished well but too late. I'MA MARY VIKING forced the early pace from the inside, remained forward but had nothing left. TWELVE STEPPER could only pass tired ones. DALIS AFFAIR pressed the early pace from the inside but had no late response. PAWPAW BOBBYS BABY could only improve position. SENSATIONAL BLUES was no factor. VERY STYLISH broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin then gave way. ZARB'S BEST had a steady fade. NORTH VINE showed little. CLASSIC

SILVERADO was always outrun.
