DIRECT ZIP up close early from the outside, dueled through the turn, gained a clear margin at the eighth pole then was all out to last. OLIVIA'S MAGICSTAR stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded but just missed. MAMA'S QUEEN well placed from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but could not match strides. TWELVE VOLT chased the early pace from the outside, remained forward for the drive but could only go evenly late. DARLING BID outrun early, advanced outside, responded and finished well. TINA'S DANCER was no real factor. SEE JANE RUN could only pass tired ones. BLONDE BROAD broke sharp from the outside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear entering the turn then tired in the drive. MARDI GRAS RAIN was no threat. KEATS KITTY had a steady fade. CLASSIC FEMME' was no threat. FLIRT CAMP was no menace.
