WILD REECE well placed from the inside early, advanced entering the turn, responded along the rail entering the drive, gained the margin and was clear late while kept to task. EASY JAZZ far back early, advanced outside entering the turn, responded and was gaining late. HUFFS MR. BIGGS forced the early going from the outside, dueled through the turn, remained forward entering the drive but could not match strides. BUDDY'S MAN outrun early, advanced outside entering the drive and finished well. WILDCAT LOVE could only improve position. WHO DAT MAX dueled from the inside early, remained engaged through the turn but tired in the drive. WELL'S GOLD was no factor. SPEEDY PERILLOUX dueled from the outside and tired. TRIPLE HIT was no threat. GOOD LUCK SHAMROCK had a steady fade.
