TIME TO REIGN was settled then rallied on the far turn while four wide, moved up to take command then drew clear in mid stretch and was ridden out in the end while clearly much the best. UNLIMITED GITGO was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while two wide, made a bid to upper stretch but was no match for the winner in the drive. PIANO RULES was unhurried early then rallied six wide on the far turn, made a strong bid but was no menace in late stretch while being best of the rest. STELLAVA RIDE was unhurried early while racing two wide on the backstretch, was blocked heading into the far turn then made a mild rally in the stretch drive. JUST WHATEVER was allowed to settled while racing three wide, made a three wide bid on the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch drive. BARNACLE BOY set the early pace, drew off on the backstretch but was used up and gave way in the stretch drive. MORGAN THE MIGHTY was well placed while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. JANSEN'S EASTERBUN chased the early pace while being rank on the backstretch, bore out on the far turn then gave way. MR KISS UP was four wide on the run down the backstretch then stayed four wide on the far turn but failed to respond when asked in the stretch. GENEROUS OFFER bobbled at the start then settled, rallied three wide on the far turn making a bid then flattened out in the stretch drive. FEAR THE HAT was unhurried early and no factor throughout. MIDNITE SHARKBITE was through early and stopped.
