XPECTTOOWIN was settled early on the rallied along the inside in the stretch, closed fast along the rail in late stretch to be up in the final strides. WILD REECE dueled for the early lead while inside, was in a long sustained drive while being all out in late stretch but could not last in the end. SWEETSOUTHERNMOON was unhurried early then rallied on the turn, swung out seven wide in upper stretch, closed fast on the outside and just missed in the end. DRYDEN was unhurried early then rallied coming out of the turn while swinging out seven wide but was no threat in the end. COLBY'S HOLIDAY dueled for the early lead while two wide, was hard used then bore out in the stretch while weakening. CHOCTAW PRINCE was on the inside on the turn but lacked a rally in the stretch. TUFFERTHANLEATHER chased the early pace then bore out in mid stretch then weakened. EVERY SUNDAY chased the pace while racing three wide, was used up then faltered in the stretch. YOU THE MON was unhurried early and lacked a rally in the stretch.
