CAT WHO DAT broke sharp from the inside, gained a clear early margin, remained clear up the backstretch, continued to show the way through the second turn, widen the margin at the eighth pole and proved much the best while kept to task. SCORPION PLACE stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn, responded but was no match for the winner. PURA VIDA forced the early pace from the inside, remained forward through the second turn but could not keep pace. LOUISIANA VAL chased the early pace inside but could only improve position. SILVER SPECIAL forced the early pace and tired. LINDOMO was never close. ESKARITA had little interest.
