POW POW chased the early pace from the inside, dropped back entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, responded and was clear late while under steady urging. ICEY'SFINALE stalked the early pace from the outside, held a forward position for the drive, responded but could not reach the winner. EASY DANCER chased the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded but could only gain the show. MY CHEROKEE MAN pressed the early pace from between foes, responded but was too late. WILDCAT'S TUNE dueled from the outside early, remained engaged through the turn but tired in the drive. CAJUN IN SEATTLE could only improve position. LIFE'S OTHER SIDE dueled from the inside and tired. WHAMS NITE OUT was no factor. MY FRIEND ROY TOO was no threat. PRINCE GO GO was no menace. ROYAL COZZE had little interest. LEADPIPEINCH showed little. HUNTERS HURRICANE had a steady fade.
