SEVERE WEATHER stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive and wore down front running CROSS EVERY BRIDGE the final furlong. CROSS EVERY BRIDGE broke sharp from between foes, gained a clear early margin, duelled up the backstretch, shook loose entering the second turn, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole but could not last. CONSERVATIVE unhurried early from the outside, crept closer entering the second turn, responded when sat down for the drive but could only hold position late. CONGO CAT veered in at the start, recovered to chase the early pace, inched closer entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive and was gaining late. WILLIST was no real factor. ST. ARIAN chased the early pace inside and tired. TEXAS CITIZEN forced the early pace outside, duelled up the backstretch then tired. WICKED VOW pressed the early pace and faded.
