JILLIAN'S GETAWAY well placed from the inside, steadily advanced entering the turn, altered outside for the drive, dueled through the drive and outnodded LONE STAR QUEST the final strides. LONE STAR QUEST stalked the early pace from the outside, inched closer entering the turn, dueled through the drive but was outnodded. BE A PRO dueled from the outside early, remained engaged through the turn, battled through the drive but was outfinished. RAINDROPSAFALLING dueled from between foes early, remained forward through the turn, battled through the drive but could not match strides. PUTABRIDLEONME could only improve position. IDEALIEN could only pass tired ones. R U'S GOLDEN LADY dueled from the inside and tired. DIXIE MISSILE was no factor. WILL BE A STORM chased the early pace and faded.
