MISS SONG out sprinted early, rallied outside in the drive and was along in time. KRISTINA'S DAY stalked POWER OF DREAMS from early on, gained the edge and while no match for the winner saved second. ADIEU AND FAREWELL unhurried, rallied between foes but lacked the needed finish. JAKE'S FLASH within striking distance, bid along the rail but did not have enough late. POWER OF DREAMS set a pressured pace and faltered late. BREAKU well back until the drive, closed mildly. ZUPPARDOS HUZZY prompted the pace three wide until before the drive and stopped. SHE'SONTHEMOVE saved ground.
